The Accounting Mentorship Program (AMP) provides personal mentorship in preparation for a successful career in the accounting and finance profession.

Sponsored by Dixon Hughes Goodman (DHG), a prominent accounting and advisory firm, and hosted by the top-ranked UNC Master of Accounting (MAC) Program, the Accounting Mentorship Program runs from September to February and includes both online workshops and live events.

Welcome reception in Chapel Hill

AMP kicks off with a visit to the UNC campus in beautiful Chapel Hill, N.C. This two-day event will allow you to meet your fellow mentees and mentors before the program starts and will include networking opportunities with DHG professionals and UNC MAC faculty, staff, and students.

Online workshops

Throughout the six-month program, you'll participate in online workshops delivered by DHG professionals and the UNC MAC team. Sessions cover important career and professional development topics that will help you build your knowledge about the accounting and finance professions.



Who should apply?

- Non-UNC Chapel Hill rising second- or third- year students
- GPA of 3.3 or better (will consider all competitive candidates)
- Underrepresented minorities, first-generation college students, and/or those that have overcome social or economic hardship are strongly encouraged to apply.

Mentorship

You'll be paired with a mentor, a DHG accounting professional, who will offer personal guidance and advice as you explore your interest in an accounting or business career. You'll speak regularly with your mentor and get an insider's view of the accounting field.

Capstone event

In February, you'll attend a three-day capstone event in Chapel Hill that includes workshops, team-building activities, and mock interviews. Additionally, you'll have opportunities to participate in an audit or tax simulation, network with leading professionals in the business world, and work on your professional brand.
